

ORDINANCE 96-16

**TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CODE ENTITLED
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

Re: Multiple-Stop for Second and Highland

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission have recommended certain changes be made in Title 15 of Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.12.010 Schedule A shall be amended to delete the following:

STOP INTERSECTIONS

Traffic on	Shall Stop for Traffic on
Second Street	Highland Avenue


SECTION II. Section 15.12.010 Schedule B shall be amended to add the following:

MULTI - STOP INTERSECTIONS

Second Street & Highland Avenue	4-Way
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
SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

This ordinance proposes an amendment to Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code that would change the intersection of Second and Highland from a 2-way Stop to a 4-way Stop. Under current ordinance the cars on Second must stop for cars on Highland Avenue. This ordinance is sponsored by Councilmember Sabbagh and comes forward with a positive recommendation from the Traffic Commission and with a negative recommendation from the City Engineer.
