

ORDINANCE 96-39

TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS
FROM IL/IS TO RS4.5

Re: 2627 West Watson;
2600, 2601, 2603, 2605, 2609½ & 2615 South Kendall Drive;
2905, 2907, 2909, & 2913 South Camden; and,
2603, 2605, 2607 & 2621 South Bryan
(City of Bloomington, Petitioner)

WHEREAS, the Common Council adopted Ordinance 95-21 which repeals and replaces Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Zoning", and including the incorporated zoning maps, and Title 21, entitled "Land Use and Development" on May 1, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-59-96, and recommended that the petitioner, City of Bloomington, be granted an amendment to the zoning maps from IL/IS to RS4.5 and request that the Common Council consider this petition;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.05.09 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that the following property be rezoned from IL/IS to RS4.5. The property includes the following addresses - 2627 West Watson; 2600, 2601, 2603, 2605, 2609½ & 2615 South Kendall Drive; 2905, 2907, 2909, & 2913 South Camden; and, 2603, 2605, 2607 & 2621 South Bryan - and is further described below:


Broadview 2nd Addition, Lot 132, Plats 1 through 10; and,

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




