

ORDINANCE 96-61

**TO AMEND TITLE 17 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION REGULATIONS"
(Fees for the Administration and Enforcement of Certain Construction Regulations)**

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Municipal Code sets forth fees for permits for construction activity within the City only through 1996; and

WHEREAS, in order to allow for permit applications and fee collections in the year 1997 the Bloomington Municipal Code must be amended to include said charges;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 17.08.050, Part (e), of the Bloomington Municipal Code, regarding Fees for the Administration and Enforcement of Construction Regulations, shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

(e) The fees shall be as follows:


<u>Permit</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Change in Occupancy fee, single family	\$0
Change in Occupancy fee, all other	\$220 + \$22 per unit or tenant
Grading permits	\$85
All earth grading under Title 20.06.05.03, one and two family	
Grading permits	\$115
All earth grading under Title 20.06.05.03, all other	
Right-of-way cuts	\$.35 per lineal ft; \$30 Min.
Must have current bond on file. Any work done in City right-of-way which requires cutting or altering any feature.	
Sign permits	\$25
Any sign erected under Title 20.06.06




