

RESOLUTION 96-20

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF AN ICE RINK FACILITY
IN THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Bloomington has operated the Frank Southern Center and its ice skating programs for thirty years; and

WHEREAS, the prospect of funding further capital improvements for this aging facility have raised questions about the feasibility of the City of Bloomington continuing to fund the facility and its ice skating programs in the future; and

WHEREAS, an Ice Rink Task Force has been formed by individuals and families who support the continuation of ice skating programs in Bloomington; and


WHEREAS, the City supports funding a study of the feasibility of operating an ice skating facility in Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, any decisions by the City regarding the funding of the facility and ice skating programs should await the findings of the feasibility study; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

1. The Common Council recognizes the Ice Rink Task Force and supports their efforts.
2. The Common Council supports funding the ice rink feasibility study.
3. The Common Council encourages cooperation between the Ice Rink Task Force, the City, and other interested members of our community in assessing this feasibility study and developing a plan for an ice facility in Bloomington.
4. If the feasibility study concludes that a new ice skating facility in Bloomington is an economically viable enterprise, and if funding sources can be secured to make it operational in a reasonable period of time, then the City recognizes the desirability of maintaining the present facility and programs until such a new facility is operational, as long as it remains economically practical to do so.


