WHEREAS, approximately \$1440 is available in the City's Municipal Building Employees Concession Fund; and


WHEREAS, this money was contributed by city employees through their use of vending machines in municipal buildings; and



PASSED and ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, upon this 10th day of November, 1996.


