## ORDINANCE 95-14

## TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS BY GRANTING A HISTORIC DESIGNATION

Re: 213 S. Rogers St. (Joe and Patricia Harrell, Petitioner)

- WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-96-94 and recommended that the petitioners, Joe and Patricia Harrell, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington Zoning Maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4, that the zoning be amended to designate 213 S. Rogers St. as a historic property. The property is further described as follows:
