RESOLUTION 95-07 IN SUPPORT OF I-69

WHEREAS, better highway access to Bloomington will improve the business environment and economic opportunities in all of South Central Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Interstate I-69 will:

- A. Promote job development and the retention of jobs in the entire southwestern part of the state, much of which suffers from high unemployment and limited economic opportunity;
- B. Improve productivity in transportation and distribution and increase accessibility for manufacturing plants in the area;
- C. Provide easier access to markets throughout North America, including Canada and Mexico; and
- D. Encourage connections between educational institutions in Evansville, Bloomington and Indianapolis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

- 1. The Common Council supports the extension of I-69 from Indianapolis through Bloomington to Evansville and on to Houston, Texas.
- 2. The Common Council urges that the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) hold public hearings especially where environmentally sensitive areas are likely to be affected by this project.
- 3. The Common Council further urges that any construction of the Indiana section of the road be delayed until completion of the Environmental Impact Statement (E.I.S.) process.
- 4. The Common Council urges the selection of the route which will maximize the usage of existing routes.
