RESOLUTION 95-15

ALLOCATION OF 1995 DISCRETIONARY SOCIAL SERVICES FUNDS

- WHEREAS, the Common Council budgeted forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for social services in 1995; and
- WHEREAS, the Social Services Funding Committee of the Common Council invited agencies to apply for these funds and 15 applications for funding were received; and
- WHEREAS, the following criteria were given to these agencies and guided the subcommittee in making their recommendation:
 - 1) The program should address a previously identified priority for social services funds (as indicated in the COMPASS or another community wide survey of social service needs); and
 - 2) The funds should provide a one-time investment that, through matching funds or other fiscal leveraging, makes a significant contribution to the program; and
 - 3) This investment in the program should lead to broad and long lasting benefits to the community;

and

- WHEREAS, after reviewing the applications, the committee invited four agencies to make presentations about their proposals; and
- WHEREAS, these four agencies were: Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Monroe County, Inc.; Community Kitchen; Girls, Inc.; and Rhino's All Ages Music Club; and
- WHEREAS, after listening to the presentations and questioning the staff of these agencies, the committee recommended that each of the four programs receive funds; and
- WHEREAS, Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Monroe County, Inc. requested \$6,279.20 for the renovation of a garage to provide office, conference, and storage space, and the committee recommended \$4,800.00 in funding for the garage renovation excluding the carpeting of the main office; and
- WHEREAS, Community Kitchen requested \$20,000.00 for a vehicle and equipment to facilitate a meal delivery program and the committee recommended \$9,000.00 in funding for a used vehicle to serve satellite meal sites; and
- WHEREAS, Girls, Inc. requested \$34,247.00 to complete the interior construction of an existing building and the committee recommended \$21,700.00 in funding to complete the interior with ventilation, but without funding for air conditioning; and
- WHEREAS, Rhino's All Ages Music Club requested \$20,000.00 to upgrade their equipment and facility and to add a youth outreach position and the committee recommended \$4,500.00 in funding to finance a pilot outreach position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council allocates the forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) set aside for social services funds in 1995 in the following manner: \$4,800 to Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Monroe County, Inc., \$9,000 to Community Kitchen, \$21,700 to Girls, Inc., and \$4,500 to Rhino's All Ages Music Club.
