APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 95-02

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE PARKING ENFORCEMENT FUND
EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED
(To Expand the Convention Center Parking Lot)

WHEREAS, it has now been determined to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;
