ORDINANCE 94-68

TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS BY GRANTING A HISTORIC DESIGNATION

Re: 514 W. Kirkwood

(Parker Real Estate Management, Inc., Petitioner)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-74-94 and recommended that the petitioners, Parker Real Estate Management, Inc. be granted an amendment to the Bloomington Zoning Maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-11 et seq., the zoning for 514 West Kirkwood be amended to designate it as a historic property. The property is further described as follows:

In Lot One Hundred Forty-six (146) in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.
