

RESOLUTION 94-10

TO APPROVE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL SHELTER OPERATION FOR THE YEAR 1994

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington desires to contract with Monroe County, through the authority of I.C. 36-1-7-2, to provide services and facilities for the City of Bloomington Animal Control Department to operate the Animal Shelter for the care and control of animals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, THAT:

The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Animal Shelter Operation for Fiscal Year 1994, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Director of the Animal Shelter of the City of Bloomington are hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Bloomington.

SYNOPSIS

This resolution approves and authorized the Mayor and Director of the Animal Shelter to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for 1994 for Animal Shelter Operation. The agreement provides that Monroe County shall pay the City of the sum of \$66,000 (48.3% of operating costs) for 1994. Percentages are based on projected personnel and operating costs minus projected fees generated from county residents and shelter space utilized for other than the Animal Shelter.
