
SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

The Police Department General Fund request would appropriate this year's portion of a county-wide grant that will be used to fund overtime salaries for OWI patrols. In total, the City will receive between \$16,000 to \$18,000 of the year long \$37,000 grant, which began October 1st.

The Police Education Fund request will be used for training and educational expenses. Funds for this statutory fund come from fees for vehicle identification number (VIN) inquiries, copies of accident reports and gun permit applications.
