WHEREAS, it has now been determined to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;


SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

The Animal Control request for money from the General Fund is for the expense of a temporary Animal Control Officer to handle cases and complaints during the extended sick leave of one of the regular Animal Control Officers.

There are three requests for money from the Fleet Maintenance Fund. One, in line 341, is for a property claim for an automobile accident involving a service vehicle and another, in line 362, is for extensive, unexpected repairs to a Track Loader at Dillman. Both of these costs will be charged back to the department in the 1996 budget. And the last, in line 372, is for rent to the Utilities Department for use of the garage facility at the Service Center that is calculated in the middle of the budget year..
