## ORDINANCE 93-15

## TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS FROM RE TO RS, GRANT PUD DESIGNATION, AND APPROVE OUTLINE PLAN Re: 1394 South State Road 446 (Steve Rumple, Petitioner)

- WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, RS/PUD-18-93, and recommended that the petitioner, Steve Rumple be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps, PUD designation, and outline plan approval and request that the Common Council consider his petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RE to RS for the property located at 1394 South State Road 446. That property is further described as follows:

Part of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section one (1), Township eight (8) North, Range One (1) West, described as follows: **Beginning** at a point that is sixty-two (62) rods North and Three Hundred Eighty-six and one half ( $386\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet west of the southeast corner of said quarter quarter section, thence running south one hundred seventy and one-half ( $170\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence west two hundred fifty-five (255) feet; thence north one hundred seventy and one-half ( $170\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence East two hundred fifty-five (255) feet to the place of beginning, containing one (1) acre, more or less.

Also, part of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section One (1), Township eight (8) North, Range one (1) West, described as follows: **Beginning** at a point that is sixty two (62) rods north and three hundred eight six and one-half ( $386\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet west of the southeast corner of said quarter quarter section; thence running south one hundred seventy and one-half ( $170\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence east one hundred twenty seven and one-half ( $127\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence north one hundred seventy and one-half ( $170\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence west one hundred twenty seven and one-half ( $127\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence or he place of beginning, containing one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acre, more or less.

Also, a right-of-way beginning at the southeast corner of the aforesaid half acre, thence east two hundred fifty five (255) feet; thence North twelve (12) feet; thence West two hundred fifty five (255) feet; thence south twelve (12) feet to the place of beginning.

Also, part of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section one (1) Township eight (8) North, Range one (1) West, described as follows: **Beginning** at a point that is eight hundred fifty-two and one-half  $(852\frac{1}{2})$  feet North of the Southeast corner of said quarter quarter Section, running thence West six hundred forty-one and one-half  $(641\frac{1}{2})$  feet, thence South one hundred seventy and one-half  $(170\frac{1}{2})$  feet; thence East six hundred forty one and one-half  $(641\frac{1}{2})$  feet; thence North one hundred seventy and one-half  $(170\frac{1}{2})$  feet to the place of beginning, containing two and one-half  $(2\frac{1}{2})$  acres more or less.

Also, a part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section one (1) Township eight (8) North, Range one (1) West, bounded as follows: **Beginning** at a apoint three hundred forty-one (341) feet, north of the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of said section running thence north three hundred forty one (341) feet, thence west six hundred forty one and one-half ( $641\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet, thence South three hundred forty-one (341) feet, thence East six hundred forty-one and one-half ( $641\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet to the place of beginning, containing five (5) acres more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline rlan be approved and that the property described be designated a FUD.

SECTION III. The Outline Plan shall be attached and made a part this ordinance.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
