

ORDINANCE 93-23

TO AMEND THE 1993 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS
AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON
(Assistant Traffic Control Specialist)

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the date this ordinance becomes effective, the following classified positions, salaries and pay schedules be incorporated into Section I of Ordinance 92-33, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:


