RESOLUTION 93-35

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF THE CURRENT MUNICIPAL BUILDING SHALL BE USED FOR PURPOSES RELATED TO THE SHOWERS PROJECT

- WHEREAS, based upon an appraisal in 1989, the current municipal building (220 E. 3rd Street) has a market value of approximately nine hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$950,000); and
- WHEREAS, the anticipated proceeds from the sale of the current municipal building should be used for purposes related to the new municipal building (Showers Project); and
- WHEREAS, in order to serve those purposes, the proceeds should be used to pay for project costs or be deposited in a debt service fund, where the money can reduce the annual lease payments made by the City from the County Option Income Tax (COIT) to the Bloomington Municipal Facilities Building Corporation or redeem bonds before maturity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The proceeds from the sale of the current municipal building shall be used to pay for Showers Project costs or be deposited in a debt service fund, where the money can reduce the annual COIT contributions to the Showers lease or redeem bonds before maturity.
