

ORDINANCE 92-10

TO AMEND THE 1992 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. From and after the date this ordinance becomes effective, the following classified positions, salaries and pay schedules be incorporated into Section I of Ordinance 91-39, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:




SECTION III. The rate shown as wages for the positions listed above is the maximum rate.

The legislation appropriates all of the monies in the Fire Capital fund for the purchase of fire equipment and land. This fund was created in 1991 as a mechanism to acquire capital items for the Fire Department. The monies in the fund were derived from the sale of the "old" headquarters fire station and from interest earnings.

The legislation also appropriates \$25,000 from the Affordable Housing fund for the purchase of land to assist in the creation of a Community Land Trust and would be used to provide affordable housing for low-income residents. This fund was also created in 1991 as a funding source to assist in the development of affordable housing. The monies in the fund were derived from the sale of property to Amethyst House.

The legislation does not have a fiscal impact on any budgeted fund.
