To Grant PUD Designation and Outline Plan Approval Re: 3000 Block of South Rogers (Willow Creek residential subdivision) (G & S Development, Corp.)

WHEREAS. the Common Council passed a Zoning ordinance amendment

and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the

Bloomington Municipal Code; and

the Plan Commission has considered this case, RS/PUD-31-92, and recommended that the petitioner, G & S WHEREAS, Development Corp., be granted PUD designation, and outline plan approval and request that the Common Council consider their petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that an outline plan be approved and the property designated a Planned Unit The property is further described as follows: Development.

A part of the southeast quarter of Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 1 West Monroe County, Indiana, being more particularly described as follows: COMMENCING at a rebar marking the southwest corner of said southeast quarter; thence North 02 degrees 48 minutes 35 seconds WEST (assumed bearings) along the west line of said southeast quarter a distance of 1322.85 feet to a stone; thence NORTH 85 degrees 31 minutes 58 seconds EAST 69.15 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar and the point of beginning; thence NORTH 01 degrees 45 minutes 13 seconds WEST along a fence line 1061.44 feet to a fence post; thence NORTH 56 degrees 44 minutes 48 seconds EAST along said fence line 19.93 feet to a fence post; thence NORTH 02 degrees 31 minutes 30 seconds WEST along said fence 240.75 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar on the south line of Country Club Hills, Phase II Section III; thence South 89 degrees 57 minutes 23 seconds WEST along the south line of Country Club Hills, Phase II Section III, Phase II Section II and Phase II Section I, a distance of 1206.92 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar, thence SOUTH 00 degrees 46 minutes 51 seconds WEST 252.80 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar; thence SOUTH 00 degrees 40 minutes 30 seconds WEST 1022.09 feet to an iron pipe on the south line of Parker Addition 498.14 feet to a P.K. nail in the centerline of Rogers Street; thence SOUTH 00 degrees 46 minutes 51 seconds WEST along said centerline 20.12 feet to a P.K. nail, thence NORTH 89 degrees 25 minutes 39 seconds WEST 240.00 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar; thence SOUTH 00 degrees 46 minutes 53 seconds WEST 235.87 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar in a fence line; thence SOUTH 89 degrees 08 minutes 39 seconds WEST along said fence line 281.92 feet to an iron pipe; thence NORTH 04 degrees 23 minutes 13 seconds WEST along fence line 190.79 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar; thence NORTH 88 degrees 19 minutes 23 seconds WEST along a fence line 1123.66 feet to the point of beginning, containing 38.05 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. The Outline Plan shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
