ORDINANCE 92 - 23 To Amend the Outline Plan Re: 5001 N. State Highway 37 (T.I.S., Inc.)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, PCD-41-92, and recommended that the petitioner, T.I.S., Inc., be granted an amendment to the Outline Plan and request that the Common Council consider their petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan amendment be approved for 5001 N. State Hwy 37, Bloomington, IN. The property is further described as follows:

Part of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the southwest corner of the said south half quarter quarter Section; thence North 00 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds EAST on and along the west line of said south half quarter quarter Section 204.89 feet to the point of beginning; thence NORTH 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds EAST 961.12 feet; thence NORTH 12 degrees 55 minutes 56 seconds WEST 434.65 feet to the north line of the south half quarter quarter Section; thence SOUTH 88 degrees 11 minutes 32 seconds WEST on and along the north line of said south half quarter quarter Section 863.88 feet to the northwest corner of said south half quarter quarter Section; thence SOUTH 00 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds WEST on and along the west line of said south half quarter quarter Section 410.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 8.756 acres more or less.

SECTION II. The Outline Plan Amendment, as recommended by the Plan Commission, shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
