

ORDINANCE 92-30

TO VACATE A PUBLIC PARCEL

RE: ALLEY LOCATED OFF WYLIE STREET AND BEHIND 714 S. ROGERS STREET
(BLOOMINGTON CONVALESCENT CENTER, PETITIONER)

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, Bloomington Convalescent Center, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property more particularly described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of I.C. 36-7-3-12, a portion of City owned property shall be vacated. The property is located off Wylie Street and behind 714 S. Rogers Street and is more particularly described as follows:

Part of Seminary Lot 45, beginning 320 feet East of the Northwest corner of said lot and 200 feet South, thence 10 feet East, thence South to the right-of-way of Wylie Street, thence West 10 feet, thence North to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
