ORDINANCE 91-2

TO AMEND THE 1991 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS
AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE
COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the date this ordinance becomes effective, the
following classified positions, salaries and pay schedules be incorporated into
Section I of Ordinance 90-29, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and
employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:


