ORDINANCE 91-12

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TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

WHEREAS, the Legal Department and the Traffic Commission have recommended certain changes be made in Title 15 of Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15.12.010 Schedule A shall be amended to add the following:

SECTION VI. Chapter 15.12.030 Signalized Intersections shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

The intersections described in Schedule D, attached hereto and made a part hereof, are designated signalized intersections. When appropriate traffic control signals are installed at each intersection, the operator of a vehicle entering the intersections shall obey the signal displayed as the driver approaches the intersection except when directed by an officer to do otherwise. The City The City Engineer shall determine which intersections shall operate during certain times with flashing signals, which days and hours such intersections shall flash, and the preferentiality of such intersections (i.e. which streets/direction shall flash red and which yellow). The operator of a vehicle entering an intersection controlled by a flashing signal shall obey the signal displayed as the driver approaches the intersection.

There will be parking spaces for the use of handicapped visiting other public locales as follows:

Bloomington Housing Authority (1007 N. Summit) -- one space limited to 30 minutes between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. except Sundays and holidays.

Bryan Park -- a total of five spaces in the following park parking lots:

two near the entrance to the swimming pools

one in the vicinity of the tennis courts

one serving the horseshoe pitching area

one in the lot off Henderson St. near the creek Cascades Municipal Golf Course -- one space at the clubhouse

County Library -- one space on Sixth Street and one space on Walnut Street.

County License Branch -- 118 South Rogers Street

Curry Building -- the first space east of Morton Street on the north side of Seventh Street.

Frank Southern Center -- one space near the North side entrance.

Glen Black and Mathers Museum (9th and Fess) -- two spaces located on 9th Street.

Health Building (119 W. Seventh) one space on Seventh Street.

Human Resources Department (One City Centre - 200 block of West Seventh Street) -- one space west of north/south alley, north side of street.

Justice Building -- the first space north of Seventh Street on the west side of College Avenue.

Miller-Showers Park -- one space near the shelter house.

Municipal Building -- one space near ramp.

Public Defender's Office -- south side of 100 block of W. Kirkwood, the first space west of the north-south alley running between Fourth and Kirkwood.

Ralph R. Mills -- one space.

Utilities Service Center (1969 S. Henderson) -- two spaces.

Winslow Sports Complex -- total of five spaces in the parking lot adjacent to the baseball fields.

SECTION XVI. Section 15.32.170 Municipal Parking Lot 5 parking during market season shall be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

No person other than a registered market vendor shall park a vehicle in a parking space in Municipal parking lot 5 located at Sixth and Lincoln Streets during the hours of 6:30 a.m. through 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays during the market season as defined by the Human Resources Department and as designated by temporary signs. Dates for the season shall be publicized throughout the community and posted in Municipal Parking Lot 5 prior to enforcement of this provision. Towing may occur for so long as the Farmers' Market is held in Lot 5.

SECTION XVII. Chapter 15.40.010 Locations shall be amended to delete the following:

(7) Lot 8: located at the northeast corner of West Kirkwood and Morton Street on part of the in-lot 157

Sub-sections (8) and (9) of Section 15.40.010 shall be renumbered (7) and (8).

SECTION XVIII. Severability. If any section, sentence, or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION XIX. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance makes several changes to the Bloomington Municipal Code. These include hours that Municipal parking lot 5 is reserved for use of the Farmers' Market only, designated handicapped parking spots, deletion of Lot 8 as a municipal parking lot, correction of a printing error referring to the Indiana Code, no parking zones, stop intersections, signalized intersections, school speed zones, speed limits, yield intersections, and limited parking areas. It also identifies the intersections where automatic signals change to flashing mode at late night hours.
