## ORDINANCE 91 - 30

To Amend the Outline Plan Re: 3200 John Hinkle Place (BRC Development Corporation)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning ordinance amendment adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS. the Plan Commission has considered this case, RL/PUD-21-91, and recommended that the petitioner, BRC Development Corporation, be granted an amendment to the outline plan and request that the Common Council consider the petition for outline plan amendment on certain property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan amendment be approved for 3200 John Hinkle Place, Bloomington, IN, and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of north right-of-way of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad and the east rightof-way of Pete Ellis Drive; thence SOUTH 77 degrees 06 minutes 26 seconds EAST 255.0 feet to the point of beginning; thence NORTH 15 degrees 03 minutes 57 seconds EAST 353.22 feet to a nontangent curve to the right the radius which bears SOUTH 12 degrees minutes 35 seconds EAST 173.28 feet through a central angle of 60 degrees 50 minutes 14 seconds; thence along said curve 183.99 feet; thence SOUTH 41 degrees 55 minutes 07 seconds EAST 141.70 feet to a tangent curve to the left the radius which bears NORTH 48 degrees 04 minutes 53 seconds EAST 354.05 feet through a central angle of 35 degrees 30 minutes 43 seconds; thence along said curve 219.44 feet; thence SOUTH 00 degrees 37 minutes 09 seconds EAST 197.61 feet to the north right-of-way of said Illinois Central Gulf Railroad; thence NORTH 77 degrees 06 minutes 26 seconds WEST along said right-of-way 56.27 feet to the point of beginning containing 3.41 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. The Outline Plan Amendment, as recommended by the Plan Commission, shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

III. SECTION This ordinance shall be in full SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
