ORDINANCE 91 - 31
To Amend the Zoning Maps from RS to ML
and to Grant Outline Plan Approval and Designate PCD
Re: Property located at the northwest corner
of Vernal Pike and Gray St.
(Joe Harrell)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ML/PCD-11-91, and recommended that the petitioner, Joe Harrell, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and outline plan approval and PCD designation and request that the Common Council consider the petition for change of zoning, outline plan approval and PCD designation on certain property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to ML for property located at the northwest corner of Vernal Pike and Gray Street, Bloomington, IN, and more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the section line dividing Sections 31 and 32, which point is 2316 feet more or less, South from the Northeast corner of section 31 and at a point which would be 169 feet, more or less, South of the center of West 11th Street if extended West to the section line dividing sections 31 and 32; thence West 152 feet; thence North 286 feet; thence East 152 feet; thence South 286 feet to the place of beginning; containing approximately 1 acre, more less;

ALSO, part of the Northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Section line dividing Section 31 and 32, which point is 2316 feet, more or less, South of the Northwest corner of Section 32 and at a point which would be 169 feet, more or less South of the center of West 11th Street if extended West to the Section line dividing Section 31 and 32; thence North on said Section line 286 feet; thence East about 290 feet to the center of Vernal Pike; thence 286 feet in a Southeasterly direction with the center of said Vernal Pike; thence in a Southwesterly direction approximately 440 feet to the place of beginning; containing approximately 2.4 acres, more or less.


Containing in all approximately 3.4 acres.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the property described above be designated a Planned Commercial Development.

SECTION III. The Outline Plan, as recommended by the Plan Commission, shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.


SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


