TO AMEND ORDINANCE 91-37 FIXING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS FOR THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That the annual salary of City Clerk of the City of Bloomington for the term beginning January 1, 1992 and extending to December 31, 1992 be amended as follows, to-wit:


City Clerk \$ 25,351

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance amends Ordinance 91-37 and changes the City Clerk's 1992 maximum salary. During the hearings on the 1992 Budget, a survey of salaries for the office of city clerk was conducted and it was determined that the average salary in other large Indiana cities was \$27,009. A \$4,300 increase was recommended by the Common Council, to be phased in over two years.
