ORDINANCE 91-43

TO AMEND THE 1991 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the date this ordinance becomes effective, the following classified positions, salaries and pay schedules be incorporated into Section I of Ordinance 90-29, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance amends the 1991 Salary Ordinance of appointed officers and employees of the City to add the positions of Code Enforcement Manager, Sidewalk Program Supervisor and COE Clerical Assistant. The Code Enforcement Manager will be responsible for ensuring code enforcement and code compliance in relation to public works, engineering, planning and housing activities. The Sidewalk Program Supervisor will be responsible for planning and organizing sidewalk and concrete construction projects. Both of these positions which are under the direction of the Public Works Department, will allow for better coordination of services among city departments and improved project management. COE Clerical Assistant is being added due to changes in MCCSC polices and the Cooperative Office Education Program (COE). These high school students who work for the City during the school year as part of their office education program will now be paid as employees of the City of Bloomington rather than contractual labor.
