

RESOLUTION 91-8

TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1300 S. ROGERS  
AS AN "ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION AREA"  
(Thomson Consumer Electronics, Inc., Petitioner).


- WHEREAS, Thomson Consumer Electronics has filed an application for designation of the property located at 1300 S. Rogers, as an "Economic Revitalization Area"; and
- WHEREAS, the application has been reviewed by the Departments of Redevelopment and Planning, and the Redevelopment Commission has passed a Resolution recommending to the Common Council the approval of the "Economic Revitalization Area" designation for said property and for said term of years; and
- WHEREAS, the Common Council has investigated the area described in detail in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, more commonly described as 1300 S Rogers; and
- WHEREAS, The property described above is partially in the Westside area as defined in the Redevelopment Department's Community Development and Housing Plan, and has experienced a cessation of growth; and
- WHEREAS, The manufacturing firm is upgrading the existing plant and acquiring new building and equipment to maintain competitiveness and avoid obsolescence,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


1. The Common council finds and determines that the area described above is an "Economic Revitalization Area" as set forth in Indiana Code 6-1,1-12.1-1 et. seq.; the Common Council further finds and determines that the owner of the property shall be entitled to a deduction from the assessed value of the property for a period of ten (10) years if the property is rehabilitated or redeveloped pursuant to I.C. 6.1.1-12-3 and shall be entitled to a deduction from the assessed value of the machinery for a period of five (5) years if the machinery is acquired in accordance with I.C. 6.1.1.-12.

2. As agreed to by Petitioner, in its application, if the improvements described in the application are not commenced (defined as obtaining a building permit and actual start of construction) within twelve (12) months of the date of the designation of the above area as an "Economic Revitalization Area", this Common Council shall have the right to void such designation.



SYNOPSIS

Thomson Consumer Electronics, Inc., represented by Frank Sheer and Al Drehobl, has filed an application for designation of the property located at 1300 S. Rogers as an "Economic Revitalization Area." Indiana law provides that upon a finding by the Common Council that an area is an "Economic Revitalization Area", property taxes are reduced on improvements to that real estate for a period of three, six, or ten years. This Resolution provides that the owners shall be entitled to a deduction for a period of ten (10) years on the property and five (5) years on the machinery. Property tax rates and assessments on land existing prior to the designation are not reduced.
