TO APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT FUNDS TO ADMINISTER JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Employment and Training will provide a grant of approximately \$2,000,000 to the City of Bloomington; and


WHEREAS, this grant provides 100% of the funding to administer job training programs in six counties; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be administered through the Human Resources Department;




