ORDINANCE 90 - 16  
To Amend the Zoning Maps from BA to RL  
and to Grant Outline Plan Approval and Designate PUD  
Re: Property located at 308 Matlock Road  
(Harold Carrithers and Robert Shaw)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, RL/PUD-16-90, and recommended that the petitioners, Harold Carrithers and Robert Shaw, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and outline plan approval and PUD designation and request that the Common Council consider the petition for change of zoning, outline plan approval and PUD designation on certain property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC-36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from BA to RL for property located at 308 Matlock Road, and more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Bloomington Township, Monroe Co., Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Southwest quarter; thence on the North line of said Southwest quarter North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 518.50 feet to the point of beginning; thence parallel with the East line of said Southwest quarter South 00 degrees 48 minutes 08 seconds East 271.06 feet; thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 501.40 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48 minutes 08 seconds West 271.06 feet to the North line of said Southwest quarter; thence on said line South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 501.40 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.12 acres, more or less.

Excepting therefrom the South right-of-way of State Road 45/46 Bypass more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West along the North line of said Southwest quarter 518.50 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 00 degrees 48 minutes 08 seconds East parallel with the East line of said Southwest quarter 95.01 feet; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 273.50 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48 minutes 08 seconds West 45.00 feet; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 227.89 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48 minutes 08 seconds West 50.01 feet to the North line of said Southwest quarter; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East along said North line 501.40 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.86 acres, more or less, and containing after said exception, 2.26 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC-36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the property including the parcel described above be designated a Planned Unit Development.

SECTION III. The Outline Plan, as recommended by the Plan Commission, shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
