ORDINANCE 90-37

To Amend Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled
"Vehicles and Traffic" (Miscellaneous Traffic Amendments)

WHEREAS, the Legal Department has recommended certain changes be made in Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic":

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section I. Section 15.38.010 Eligibility shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Any person employed as an officer or official of the City, or by any agency, department or office thereof, who owns a vehicle, may apply to the City Parking Enforcement Division for a public employee parking permit for parking privileges on the streets, parts of streets, or the part of Municipal Lot Number 6 designated as public employee parking zones by Section 15.32.185.

Section II. Section 15.38.020 Information required in application shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Application and issuance of permit - The application form shall contain the name of the employee applying for the permit, and shall be submitted to the City Parking Enforcement Division, which shall issue a permit.

Section III. Section 15.38.030 Display of permits shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

No person shall park on the streets, parts of streets, or the part of Municipal Lot Number 6 designated as public employee parking zones without a public employee parking permit sticker displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the rear window of the vehicle, or in such other location designated by the City Parking Enforcement Division.

Section IV. Section 15.38.050 Issuance of Permits shall be repealed.

Section V. Section 15.38.060 Violation and Penalty shall be amended to be renumbered as Section 15.38.050.

Section VI. Section 15.32.185 Public Employee Parking and Schedule T shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule T, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the parking area at the 200 block of East Third Street, without parking meters (not a part of City Municipal Lot 6 as defined in Chapter 15.40.010 nor the handicapped parking space located there, as stated in Chapter 15.32.150 Schedule S), are designated as public employee parking zones. When appropriate signs are erected, no person shall park a

vehicle upon any of the streets, parts of the streets, or the said parking lot unless that person has obtained a public employee parking permit, and has properly displayed said permit as provided for by Chapter 15.38.

Section VII. Section 15.12.030 Schedule D shall be amended to add the following:

SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS

Covenant Drive and College Mall Road
Jordan Avenue and Law Lane
Rogers Street and Third Street
Hillside and High Street

Section VIII. Section 15.32.150(d) Handicapped Parking Spaces shall be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle without a valid handicapped parking permit, valid disabled veteran's registration plate, or a valid handicapped registration plate or decal (all issued under the laws of Indiana or any state or province), in a handicapped parking space. Tickets issued by uniformed officers of the Bloomington Police Department for violations of this section shall be referred to the Monroe County Prosecutor for enforcement as a Class C infraction.

Section IX. Section 15.32.150 shall be amended to add the following:

- (e) Parking in a handicapped parking space, by a vehicle not bearing a valid handicapped parking permit, valid disabled Veteran's registration plate, or a valid handicapped registration plate or decal, shall also be a violation of the Bloomington Municipal Code. Such violation shall be a Class C (Potentially dangerous) Traffic Violation.

Section X. Section 15.64(c) Class C Traffic Violations (Potentially dangerous violations) shall be amended to add the following:

15.32.150(e) Parking illegally in handicapped parking space

Section XI. Severability. If any section, sentence, or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section XII. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, approval by the Mayor and promulgation according to law.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance amends Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, designating a portion of the parking lot appurtenant to the Municipal Building as a municipal employee parking lot. It also adds three intersections to the list of those designated as signalized intersections. This Ordinance provides that parking in a handicapped parking space by a vehicle not bearing handicapped plates or decal shall be a Potentially dangerous parking violation.
