AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PARKING METER FUND

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-43 authorized a transfer of funds from the Parking Meter Fund to the General Fund to be used as an advance to acquire land for the new downtown fire station; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available from the proceeds of the First Mortgage Bonds issued by the Bloomington Municipal Facilíties Corporation to repay said advance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The sum of \$235,000 is hereby transferred from Fund 101 - General to Fund 301 - Parking Meter.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.
