RESOLUTION 90-8

TO APPROVE THE FIRE DISPATCHING INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, BLOOMINGTON TOWNSHIP, VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP, THE TOWN OF ELLETTSVILLE, AND THE PERRY-CLEAR CREEK FIRE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City and contracting parties are authorized by Ind. Code §36-1-7-1 et seq. to buy, sell, and exchange services via Interlocal Cooperation Agreements; and

WHEREAS, central dispatch of fire calls by the City over the radio alert network to contracting parties has enabled all calls to ring in and be dispatched for the mutual benefit and safety of all parties and citizens; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to continue to assist contracting parties in providing the most effective and efficient fire protection possible; and



SYNOPSIS

This Resolution approves and authorizes the Mayor, Fire Chief, and Police Chief to execute the Fire Dispatching Interlocal Cooperation Agreement. This Agreement provides for the central dispatch of all fire calls received on the 911 and 331-1111 fire numbers by the Bloomington Police Department. This agreement constitutes a three (3) year renewal of the previous three (3) year agreement which expires in March of 1990.

## FIRE DISPATCHING AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1990, by and between the City of Bloomington (hereinafter referred to as "City") and Bloomington Township, Van Buren Township, the Perry-Clear Creek Fire District, and the Town of Ellettsville (hereinafter "contracting parties"). This Agreement constitutes a renewal of and amendment to the three (3) year Agreement which expires March 16, 1990. The duration of this Renewal Agreement shall be three (3) years from March 16, 1990. Provided, however, in the event that an E911 system is installed and functioning to provide service to Monroe County, this Agreement may be amended or declared void.

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue to assist contracting parties in providing the most effective and efficient fire protection possible; and

WHEREAS, the City and contracting parties are authorized by Ind. Code §36-1-7-1 et seq. to buy, sell, and exchange services via Interlocal Cooperation Agreements; and

WHEREAS, central dispatch of fire calls by the City over the radio alert network to contracting parties has enabled all calls to ring in and be dispatched for the mutual benefit and safety of all parties and citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY AND CONTRACTING PARTIES DO HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The City, through the Bloomington Police Department, shall continue to provide personnel and equipment for fire dispatching, pay for the telephone line, and receive and dispatch all fire and rescue calls received on the 911 and 333-1111 fire numbers. All fire and rescue calls shall be dispatched immediately over the radio alert network, and the dispatcher shall log the time, monitor for a call back, and rebroadcast if not acknowledged by a responding department.
- (2) This Agreement shall be administered through the "Fire Dispatching Agreement Joint Board," consisting of the Fire Chief of each contracting party and the Police and Fire Chief of the City.

(3) In consideration of the equipment and personnel costs associated with this Agreement, each contracting party shall pay the City two hundred twenty five dollars (\$225.00) per year throughout the duration of this Agreement. Payments shall be made at the completion of each year's service to the City Controller.
