

RESOLUTION 90-9

TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION BY THE BLOOMINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT  
FOR A STATE ENFORCEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, the State periodically awards grants to partially reimburse local government enforcement agencies for overtime costs related to enforcement of "operating a vehicle while intoxicated" laws; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington Police Department is applying for such a grant in the amount of \$5,000 to partially reimburse the department for its overtime costs; and

WHEREAS, the State requires approval and authorization from the Bloomington Common Council in order for the City of Bloomington, through its Police Department, to apply for the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council hereby authorizes the City of Bloomington, through the Police Department, to apply for a grant from the State in the amount of \$5,000 for the purpose of partially reimbursing the department for its overtime costs that are attributable to enforcement of "operating a vehicle while intoxicated" laws.
