
TO EXPRESS SUPPORT BY THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FOR
THE UNITED NATIONS WORLD SUMMIT FOR CHILDREN

- WHEREAS, our future depends on the children of our community and our world; and
- WHEREAS, children's lives and well-being are threatened worldwide by malnutrition, lack of health care, lack of education, homelessness, and all manner of exploitation and abuse; and
- WHEREAS, 40,000 children die yearly in the United States and 40,000 die every day in developing countries, the great majority from easily preventable causes; and
- WHEREAS, a World Summit for Children is scheduled at the United Nations on September 29-30, 1990 to spur improvements in the condition of children in every nation; and
- WHEREAS, a candlelight vigil is scheduled to be observed in Bloomington, Indiana on Sunday, September 23 as part of a world-wide movement to support this Summit and to create momentum behind improvements in the well-being of all children;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The City of Bloomington supports the World Summit for Children and urges citizens to participate in the local Candlelight Vigil for Children and to inform themselves about steps that can be taken to improve the lives of children in our own community and world-wide.


