

To Establish a Cumulative Building and Capital Improvement Fund

WHEREAS, Chapter 36-9-16 of the Indiana Code provides for the establishment of a Cumulative Building and Capital Improvement Fund, and

WHEREAS, said fund may be used for a variety of capital improvement purposes, and

WHEREAS, such purposes are set out in Section 36-9-16-2 and 3 of the Indiana Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, THAT:

SECTION I. A Cumulative Building and Capital Improvement Fund is hereby created at a tax rate not to exceed \$1.00 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation. A tax rate not to exceed \$.15 is hereby approved for 1990.

SECTION II. Said fund shall be used for capital improvement purposes pursuant to Section 36-9-16-2 and 3 of the Indiana Code.

SECTION III. Expenditures from this fund shall be made only after annual appropriation by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Indiana State Board of Tax Commissioners.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor and the Indiana State Board of Tax Commissioners.

SECTION V. Severability. If any section of this ordinance or any part of any section shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional such declaration shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions.

The budget, tax levy and tax rate for the fund were also included in the 1990 Civil City budget.
