RESOLUTION 89-34

TO AUTHORIZE USE OF THE
SPECIAL NON-REVERTING FUND

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Common Council adopted Ordinance 79-74, "To Create a Special Non-Reverting Fund"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 85-39 provides that monies in said fund may be used for professional services, salaries, materials and equipment necessary to prepare fiscal plans and other reports and studies necessary to allow annexation of areas contiguous to the City of Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain a consultant to prepare an update to the comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, an update to the comprehensive plan will assist the City in determining and defending future annexations; and


WHEREAS, forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) has been approved in the 1990 Planning Department budget in order to hire said consultant, and an additional twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) is needed to fully fund this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:


The Common Council of the City of Bloomington hereby approves and authorizes expenditures from the Special Non-Reverting Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the purpose of hiring a consultant to prepare an update to the comprehensive plan. This project will also be funded by forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) previously approved in the 1990 Planning Department budget.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




