WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:





SYNOPSIS

These appropriations are for two projects included in the Planning Department's FY 1989 Overall Work Program. Both projects are to be funded on a reimbursement basis with one-time PL Discretionary Funds provided by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) through the Indiana Department of Highways (IDOH).

The \$20,000 appropriation from LR&S will be used to install four permanent traffic counting stations. Of this amount, \$17,000 is the Federal share and \$3,000 is the local match.

The \$6,000 appropriation from CCD will be used to contract for updated topographic maps for selected township sections in the urbanized area. Of this amount, \$5,100 is the Federal share and \$900 is the local match.
