To Amend Chapter 15.32.120 of the Bloomington Municipal Code To Delete the Designation of An Official Vehicle Zone in Schedule R and Substitute Another

WHEREAS. the Common Council is authorized by statute to regulate parking on City streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Police Department no longer requires an official vehicle zone on Walnut Street in front of the former Police Station, but does require a zone instead on the west side of the Justice Building in the alley running north and south;
