

To Amend the Zoning Maps from RS to MP
RE: 1905 Vernal Pike (Arthur Staggs)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-69-88, and recommended that the petitioner, Arthur Staggs, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to MP for property located at 1905 Vernal Pike, and more particularly described as follows:


A part of the west half of Section 32, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County Indiana. Commence at the northwest corner of said section 32, said corner being marked by a found railroad spike; thence South 00 degrees 36 minutes 52 seconds West 1546.52 feet along section line between sections 31 and 32 to the centerline of Vernal Pike; thence South 30 degrees 48 minutes 34 seconds East 714.35 feet along the centerline of Vernal Pike to a P.K. nail set at the centerline of West 11th Street; thence South 32 degrees 52 minutes 45 seconds East along centerline of Vernal Pike 162.89 feet to a P.K. nail set at the centerline of GRay Street; thence South 33 degrees 02 minutes 44 seconds East along centerline of Vernal Pike 96.63 feet to a P.K. nail; thence South 36 degrees 11 minutes 27 seconds East along centerline of Vernal Pike 53.79 feet to a P.K. nail set at the point of beginning of herein described parcel; thence South 41 degrees 57 minutes 26 seconds East 30.87 feet along centerline of Vernal Pike; thence South 46 degrees 17 minutes 21 seconds East 59.48 feet along centerline of Vernal Pike; thence South 50 degrees 14 minutes 40 seconds East 76.06 feet to a P.K. nail; thence South 10 degrees 14 minutes 59 seconds West 199.94 feet to a found pipe; thence North 78 degrees 49 minutes 17 seconds West 291.52 feet to a found pipe; thence North 03 degrees 30 minutes 49 seconds West 128.83 feet to a found pipe; thence North 60 degrees 08 minutes 11 seconds East 136.57 feet; thence North 57 degrees 38 minutes 18 seconds East 105.27 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.58 acres more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
