

To Amend Title 9 of the
Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled "Water"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 9.08.010 Monthly rates generally of Chapter 9.08 of title 9 of
the Bloomington Municipal Code, shall be amended to read as follows:

9.08.010 Monthly rates generally. The following rates and charges are established
for the use of and service rendered by the water utility of the city. Each customer
will pay a monthly charge according to the following schedules:

Monthly usage charge applicable to Residential, Commercial, Industrial,
Interdepartmental, and Indiana University Revenue Meter Classes.
