

RESOLUTION 88-15

To Approve Application for a Federal Action  
Drug Abuse Prevention Grant

WHEREAS, the Program Demonstration and Development Division of ACTION requires approval and authorization from the Common Council of the City of Bloomington for the City of Bloomington, through the Human Resources Department, to apply for a Thirty Eight Thousand Dollar (\$38,000) grant; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide one hundred percent (100%) funding for a program to mobilize and coordinate low-income youth and parents, community organizations, businesses, religious institutions and local government into effective drug abuse prevention networks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that:

SECTION I. The City of Bloomington is authorized to receive and administer through the Human Resources Department, a Federal ACTION Drug Abuse Prevention Grant in the amount of \$38,000.00 for the purposes expressed herein.
