## SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates Federal (75%) and local matching (25%) funds for the development of fishing access improvements for Riddle Point Park at Lake Lemon. The project includes widening/paving of the boat launch road, paving of the adjacent service parking lot, construction of a boat dock with ten slips, installation of a handicapped accessible fishing pier and shoreline erosion protection. An appropriation for this project was approved in 1987 but could not be encumbered because Federal grant approval was not received until November; thus, funds must be re-appropriated in 1988.
