

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 88-1

To Specially Appropriate from the Parks & Recreation and Indiana Waters Grant Funds Expenditures Not Otherwise Appropriated

WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the fund herein named and for the purpose herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates Federal (75%) and local matching (25%) funds for the development of fishing access improvements for Riddle Point Park at Lake Lemon. The project includes widening/paving of the boat launch road, paving of the adjacent service parking lot, construction of a boat dock with ten slips, installation of a handi-capped accessible fishing pier and shoreline erosion protection. An appropriation for this project was approved in 1987 but could not be encumbered because Federal grant approval was not received until November; thus, funds must be re-appropriated in 1988.
