ORDINANCE 87-1

TO AMEND ORDINANCE 86-39 FIXING SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 1987.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. From and after this _____ day of January, 1987, the following classified position, salary, and pay schedule for the Personnel Office shall be incorporated into Section I. of Ordinance 86-39, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, for the year 1987:

SECTION I. Personnel	Asst. Director of Personnel	\$20,825

SECTION II. The rate shown as salary and wages for the position listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
