ORDINANCE 87-14

To Amend Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "Vehicle and Traffic" (To Designate the North side of Sixth Street a No Parking zone)

WHEREAS, The Bloomington Traffic Commission has met and recommended certain changes in Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", and the Legal Department requests an additional change:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS IN TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Section 15.32.080 No Parking Zones Schedule M shall be amended to add the following:

Street

From

To

Side/Street

Time/Restriction

Sixth St.

240' West Dunn St.

North

Anytime

Section 15.60.040 "Driving or Parking on Sidewalks" shall SECION II. be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle within any sidewalk area. No person shall drive a vehicle within any sidewalk area, except upon a permanent or temporary driveway. Any driving violation under this Section is a Class C Traffic Violation and subject to the penalty listed in Section 15.64.010(c). Any parking violation under this Section is a Class D Traffic Violation and subject to the penalty listed in Section 15.64.010(d).

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance makes the North side of Sixth Street a No Parking Anytime zone to provide access to the proposed Poplars Parking Garage; in addition, the Ordinance amends Section 15.60.040 to clarify the fact that parking in a sidewalk area, as opposed to driving across such area on a permanent or temporary driveway, is not permitted.
