ORDINANCE 87-15 To amend the zoning map from RH to BL. RE: 1931 North Dunn Street (Varsity Villas)

WHEREAS,

the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-80-86, and recommended that the petitioner, Varsity Villas Corp., be denied an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning not be changed from RH to BL for property located at 1931 No. Dunn, and more particularly described as follows:

A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 28; Thence North 01 degrees 26 minutes 00 seconds West (assumed bearing) along the East line of saidSlouthwest Quarter 1801.06 feet; Thence South 88 degrees 49 minutes 00 seconds West 22.00 feet to the apparent West right of way of Dunn Street and to the point of beginning:

Thence South 01 degrees 26 minutes 00 seconds East 70.07 feet along said West right of way; Thence South 02 degrees 22 minutes 51 seconds West 83.10 feet along said West right of Way ot the Northeast corner of Varsity Villas Section II; Thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 159.54 feet along the North line of said Varsity Villas Section II to a point on the Southeasterly line of Varsity Villas Section IV; Thence North 57 degrees 27 minutes 55 Seconds East 6.27 feet; Thence North 32 degrees 32 minutes 05 seconds West 57.27 feet; Thence North 57 degrees 27 minutes 55 seconds East 19.54 feet; Thence North 32 degrees 25 minutes 40 seconds West 102.19 feet; Thence North 88 degrees 49 minutes 00 seconds East East 225.14 feet and to the point of beginning, containing 0.65 acres, more or less.
