

ORDINANCE 87-56

To Transfer Appropriations Within the General Fund

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section I. The Controller may adjust the appropriations of the following budget, to wit:

GENERAL FUND

Planning

From: Line 442 Equipment Purchases \$800.

To: Line 394 Contractual Services \$800.

Sanitation

From: Line 224 Fuel and Oil \$6,518.  
Line 442 Equipment \$3,100.

To: Line 111 Salaries & Wages \$9,618.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.
