

RESOLUTION 87-11

To Authorize Receipt and Administration of A Federal Action
Drug Abuse Prevention Grant

WHEREAS, the Federal Action Drug Alliance requires approval and authorization from the Common Council of the City of Bloomington for the City of Bloomington to receive and administer through the Human Resources Department a Thirty Five Thousand Dollar (\$35,000) grant; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide one hundred percent (100%) funding for a program to strengthen and expand community-based volunteer efforts in drug abuse prevention;
