

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 87-11

To Specially Appropriate From the Fire Station Construction Fund and the Law Enforcement continuing Education Fund Expenditures Not Otherwise Appropriated

WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the fund herein named and for the purpose herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates proceeds from investment of Fire Station Construction Fund cash for the purchase of radio equipment, pump equipment, and new station furniture. It also appropriates funds in the Law Enforcement Continuing Education Fund for the purpose of sending a police officer to the University of Louisville's Administrative Officers Course. The LECEF was created this year under new state legislation and is funded by a \$3.00 charge collected when a defendant is in violation of a statute or a local ordinance.
