

ORDINANCE 86 - 27

To Amend the Outline Plan for the Planned Commercial Development at 905 N. Smith (Eastside Investments)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this, PCD-22-86, and recommended that the petitioners, EASTSIDE DEVELOPMENTS, be granted an amendment to an approved Planned Commercial Development outline plan that the Common Council consider their petition for amendment to said approved outline plan for certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the outline plan be amended for property located at 905 N. Smith, and more further described as:

Part of the Northeast quarter of Section 35, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of Smith Pike Road, said point being 79.70 feet measured northwesterly along the center of said road from its intersection with the south line of said Northeast quarter; thence running north 03 degrees 10 minutes east for a distance of 66.0 feet; thence running north 83 degrees 30 minutes east for a distance of 162.0 feet; thence running north 49 degrees 23 minutes west for a distance of 121.0 feet and to the center of State Road 45 to its intersection with the center of Smith Pike Road; thence in a southeasterly direction on and along the center of said road to the place of beginning, containing in all 2.5 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be amended for the above-mentioned Planned Commercial Development.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
